an activity that explores ideas through the process of drawing, building, designing, and problem-solving



* 1. NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE WITH GOD [HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Nothing Is Impossible with God" Activity Page, Bible marked at Psalm 27, crayons, red, orange and yellow tissue paper scraps, cups of water, paint brushes, towels

TODAY'S BIBLE STORY

Fire on the Mountain

Elijah and the Prophets of Baal
1 Kings 18:16-46

WHAT YOU DO:

- Give each kid an Activity Page.
- Lead kids to point to the words as you read the verse aloud.
- Encourage kids to either say the verse with you or think it in their heads.
- Guide kids to color the wood and the stones.
- Show kids how they can brush water over the paper and attach bits of torn tissue paper to the moistened areas.
- Remind kids of the four GIANT jars of water that the Israelites poured over Elijah's altar.
- As kids work, unpack how Elijah and the Israelites saw God's goodness.

TODAY'S BOTTOM LINE

God can do the impossible.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Psalm 27:13 tells us that we can be CONFIDENT that we'll see God's goodness. How did Elijah and the Israelites see God's goodness? (*They saw God do the impossible; they saw God send fire and rain.*) God is good, and **God can do the impossible.**

MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE

**I remain confident of this:
I will see the goodness of the
Lord in the land of the living.**
Psalm 27:13, NIV

"We may never see God do the impossible, but we can see proof of His goodness and His power when we see the world He made! Just by speaking, God made the sun, moon, and stars; He made all the plants and trees; and He made all the animals that swim, fly, and walk. Best of all, God made people! God made YOU! Can God do the impossible? (*Pause.*) Yes, **God can do the impossible.** And God is GOOD!"

4. PRAY AND DISMISS [PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Coins

WHAT YOU DO:

- Guide kids to gather around you.
- Set the coins in the configuration from “Early Arriver”:
five coins across and three coins down at the middle coin.
- Remind kids of the challenge: move just two coins to make five coins across AND five coins down. Ask: Is it impossible?
- Show kids the solution. Stack the two end coins from the row of five onto the middle coin, creating a “tower” of three coins.
- Count the five coins across and the five coins down.
- Use the conversation below as a guide to lead kids into prayer.

WHAT YOU SAY:

“Finding a way to make five coins across and five coins down wasn’t impossible. There was a trick to it. With God, NOTHING is impossible. And for Him, it’s not a trick—it’s REAL. God created the world and everything in it. God sent fire to burn up a sacrifice. God controlled the rain. And God gave His One and only Son to be our Savior! **God can do the impossible!**”

“So do you think that you can trust God, no matter what? (Pause.) You bet you can! God loves you, and He is with you! And He is always in control. Let’s pray.

“Dear God, thank you SO much that You can do the impossible. You created the world and everything in it. You sent fire to burn up a sacrifice. You controlled the rain. And You gave Your One and only Son to be our Savior! You can do the IMPOSSIBLE! Thank You that You love us and that You are ALWAYS with us! We love You SO much, God. Thank You! Amen.”

As adults arrive to pick up, encourage kids to tell parents today’s **God can do the impossible**. You can prompt kids by saying the first part then pausing for them to complete it.
