## Maximize Your Reach TO OTHERS

It seems like nearly everyday I am receiving some kind of reminder, either from my family about the events of the week, or a text from my doctor or dentist office about appointments, even from my calendar on my phone about upcoming meetings, that is as long as I program it correctly.

The truth is we all need a helpful reminder from time to time, and when you're talking about reaching others with the gospel nothing is more important. God has placed you in the lives of others for a purpose. Spend time thinking about all the people you know or regularly come in contact with. God can use you to speak truth in their lives.

Here are 10 ideas to help open the door to having gospel conversations with others.

1. Make a prayer list of friends and family.
2. Send an encouraging text to a different person each day.
3. Be ready for Trick or Treaters, include an invite to Night of Hope.
4. Leave treats and a note for delivery drivers.
5. If you have a new neighbor move in be intentional in meeting them and begin to pray for them by name.
6. Prayer-walk your neighborhood or areas of our city.
7. Be intentional about asking people how you can pray for them.
8. Invite a friend for coffee and share what God has been doing fresh in your life.
9. Seek out opportunities for random acts of kindness.
10. Be thankful for others and show your appreciation.
